## Norfolk Baptists

- First List of Members. St. Marv's. a.1691 Norwich Church Book. William Wainford Joined Norwich Congregational 1644 Church (Old Meeting Church Book). Attended the funeral of John Pend-1656 raves at Abingdon. (A Complaining Testimony). 1656 Prayed in prayer meeting that "God would be pleased to throw down all earthly rule." (Norwich Court of Mayoralty records). a.1691 First list of Church Members. (St. Mary's Church Book). St. Mary's, Norwich; first list. Edmund Wattling a.1691 John Wattling a.1691 St. Mary's, Norwich; first list. St. Mary's, Norwich; third list. William Watts a.1698 1705 Freeman Baker of Norwich after apprenticeship to Richard Spratt (q.v.). 1725 Deacon. Mr. Wildeman 1646 Minister of Pulham Baptist Church which consulted the Norwich Congregationalists at this time about his call to Beverley. (Old Meeting Church Book). He may have been Francis (M.A. 1642) or John (M.A. 1644) both of Norfolk and educated at Corpus Christi, Cambridge. (Venn). Given liberty by Hercules Collin's Edward Williams 1681 church in Old Gravel Lane, London, to join Brother Kiffin's Congregation. c.1690 Came to Norwich consequent upon Richard Tidmarsh's report of his tour through the Eastern counties. 1691 Entries in St. Mary's, Norwich first Church Book in his hand. 1692 Accompanied Henry Austine as representative of Norwich at the London Assembly of Particular Baptists. (Ivimey, Vol. I, p. 508). 1714 Died aged 73. Buried at Norwich Old Meeting.

  - c.1726 Died leaving  $\pounds 50$  to the poor of the Church.
