Calvary Baptist Theological Seminary is a non-profit corporation chartered in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania February 4, 1976. The Seminary has received approval for the training of veterans and foreign students. Authorization to award the Master of Divinity degree was received October 5, 1979, the Master of Theology degree, April 1, 1985, and the Doctor of Ministry degree, June 5, 1986.

Calvary Baptist Theological Seminary was founded in 1976 by Dr. E. Robert Jordan, Pastor-Emeritus of Calvary Baptist Church, Lansdale, who served as President 1976-1986. Dr. Timothy R. Jordan became President on November 16, 1986. David L. Burggraff is Dean. Robert H. Stitzinger, Sr. is Registrar and Business Manager. Clint Banz is Librarian.

Calvary Baptist Theological Seminary offers post-college professional training for the Gospel ministry. The academic year consists of fall and spring semesters and concentrated sessions in January and during the summer. Inquiries should be addressed to Gregory Odiorne, Director of Student Relations. For the second professional degree (D.Min.) David L. Burggraff serves as the Director of the Doctor of Ministry program with Timothy R. Jordan, Supervisor of Pastoral Studies, Douglas P. Finkbeiner, Supervisor of Christian Education, and Sam Harbin, Supervisor of Counseling Studies.
