

months of July, August, and September, was mostly from the S.W., and in October from the east and north. On the 4th day of July the air was so clear that the mountains of Cyprus, distant about 135 miles, were distinctly visible at sunset.

Showers of rain fell on August 13th and 19th, and September 18th and 21st.

The following results were deduced from observations taken at the JEWISH COLLEGE, GHIAZIR, MOUNT LEBANON, at about 1300ft. above the level of the sea. The barometer observations were taken with two Aneroid barometers, the reading of which agreed well together, and those of temperature with French instruments (whose characters are unknown) in the months of March and April, and with English in the months of May and June. The headings of each column will give sufficient explanation; but the returns are too few to be able to speak with any confidence as to their value:
